I accept and assume all responsibility for all risks which may occur during, in connection with, or result from my participation in this FPC activity including, but not limited to, potential injury while working.

**RELEASE:** With the above in mind and by my signature below, I fully understand, agree and hereby voluntarily release and forever discharge FPC and PCUSA. FPC and PCUSA shall not be responsible or liable in any way for any accident, loss, death, injury or damage to myself or my property, in connection with my participation in any portion of this FPC activity even if said injury or action is due to the alleged negligence of FPC or PCUSA. Further, I do hereby agree to indemnify and hold FPC and PCUSA harmless against any and all liabilities, damages, claims, actions or rights of action, suits, judgments and associated costs and expenses (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees) of whatsoever kind in connection with my participation in any portion of this activity.
