SURVEY FOR CONGREGATIONS

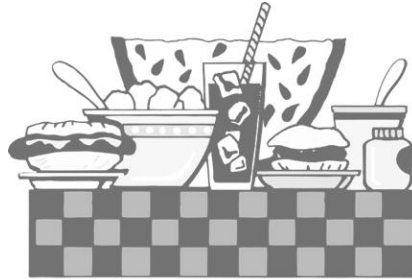
