Many of the banners in the sanctuary for the next month or so are related to The Great Ends of the Church, six core purposes guiding the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and providing a roadmap for faith in action. They define our denomination's mission as 1) proclaiming the gospel, 2) nurturing the children of God, 3) maintaining divine worship, 4) preserving truth, 5) promoting social righteousness, and 6) displaying God's Kingdom. Each Sunday, a banner related to one of these Great Ends will hang beside the altar on the pulpit side, and a banner depicting the day's confession will hang beside the altar on the piano side. This week, the Great Ends banner is for Proclaiming the Gospel, and the Confession banner is for The Brief Statement of Faith.
